We still have a limited amount of extra yearbooks that may be purchased in the school office. The cost of the yearbook is \$45

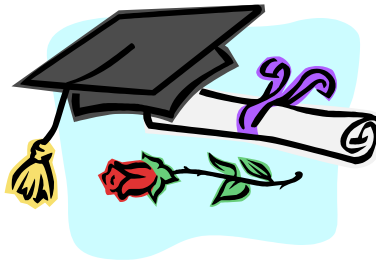
## ALUMNI NEWS
